Bishop Bradley Requesting Second Collection for Haiti

"As our Church mourns and our hearts break over the terrible devastation caused by the earthquake in Haiti our faith compels us to come together to support our brothers and sisters both through our prayers and our generosity" (Bishop Bradley). - January is the month we mourn the babies lost after 37 years of legalized abortion.
