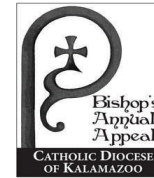

**Project Hope**

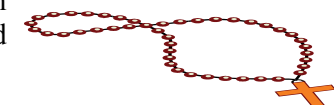
