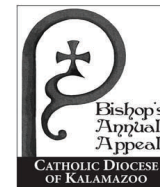

**Greeting from  
Father Anthony Bitchapogu.**



I was born in a remote village of India. I am the youngest of six children. Before I was born, my mother had been very ill and was in a lot of pain. There were no doctors or hospitals, only missionary priests with a little medical knowledge. My mother prayed the rosary daily asking Our Lady for help during her illness. My mother promised to dedicate her next child to God. This child would also become a priest. After a few months, the pain was gone and the missionary priests couldn't find anything wrong with her. My mother is now 86 years old. I was born two months after my father died. When I was a little older, my mother told me how she had prayed to Our Mother and also about her promise. From then on, I knew I would become a priest. I entered the seminary when I was 13 years old. The seminary was 200 miles away from home, so I was not able to come home for visits. I was only able to write letters to my family. I was ordained a priest in 1992. I came to Michigan in July 2007. Since then, I have been an associate pastor of St. Joseph's Parish in Kalamazoo and chaplain of Borgess Hospital. Two weeks ago, the Bishop asked me if I would go to St. Stanislaus as administrator, I was shocked and surprised. After a few days of prayer and meditation, for the glory of God, I said yes to the order of the Bishop, ultimately the will of God. I believe that God will not lead me without his grace. I take this position as an honor and privilege to serve you, as your priest. Here, I come, as a novice and newest member of this parish. I greatly count on your support, love and prayers. I am confident that with the grace of God and with your help and co-operation, we can grow as one family in the knowledge, strength and understanding of God. Let us turn to Christ, the prince of peace, and implore him to reconcile, heal and bring peace to our lives, families, community, our country and the whole world.
